### Liberty Division Sea Cadets

We are with the Liberty Division Sea Cadets in Lake City, Florida. We meet twice a month at the American Legion on Saturdays from 7:30 am to about 4:00 pm. We are a US Navy sponsored program for young men and women from ages 10 to 17.

Our drill days include physical training, classroom training, field exercises, drill, and fun activities. This year we will have some joint drill with FDR Division (Jacksonville) to include a campout and the Blue Angels Air Show at NAS Jax and the Seal Team

Muster in Ft. Pierce at the Sea Team Museum. We are also attempting to set up tours of Navy ships in Jacksonville and surrounding areas.

The cost for the first year is \$180.00. We supply a full set of uniforms for the Cadets. Training is also available for Cadets to travel to other locations during winter, spring and summer breaks. Training is available in a number of fields including aviation,

Coast Guard, construction, dive, food services, international exchange, leadership/professional development, medical and health, Navy shore, public safety and seamanship.

Sea Cadets are broken into two groups, League Cadets (Ages 10-13) and Sea Cadets (Ages 14-17).

Opportunities are also available for adults who want to assist with the program as leaders and instructors. No military experience is necessary.


